

New Out-of-Boundary ADA Dial-A-Ride Service



Ben Franklin Transit now provides ADA Paratransit services to Dial-A-Ride eligible persons who live in or travel to and from destinations ***within 5 miles of Ben Franklin Transit's existing boundaries.*** Out-of-boundary trips are limited to Benton and Franklin Counties.

This service is a door to door, demand response service operating just like our Dial-A-Ride service in the Tri-Cities.

To use service, you must first be determined eligible for Dial-A-Ride services. *

Once you are eligible for service you may reserve your ride by calling Tri-City Taxi at 547-7777 between 8:00 AM and 5:00 PM at least one day before your trip.

Since this is a premium service, the fare will be ***two dollars per one-way trip.*** Dial-A-Ride passes and ten-ride tickets will be accepted as partial fare plus one dollar.
